- 1. Nepal has received loan from Asian Development Bank (ADB) toward the cost of Urban Water Supply and Sanitation (Sector) Project (UWSSP). Part of this financing will be used payments under the contracts named above. Bidding is open to Bidders from eligible source countries of ADB.
- The Project Management Office, Urban Water Supply and Sanitation (Sector) Project (UWSSP), Department of Water Supply and Sewerage management, Ministry of Water Supply ("the Employer") invites sealed bids from eligible bidders, based on post-qualification criteria, for the scope of works described hereunder:

Stage- 1: 5 Deep Tube Wells, 1 RCC OHTs, Pumping Lines, 265 km Distribution Pipe Lines, 103 Valve Chambers for Flow Control Valve, Air Relief Valve and Wash out Valve, 2 RCC Distribution Chamber with SCADA system, 22 Fire Hydrants, Office Building, Generator/Operator House, Electro-mechanical Installations including SCADA, 3952 House Installations (Connections) and other axillary structures are the main new project components. Likewise, for Sanitation Component 1 Public Toilet is included in the project.

Stage- 2: Operations and Maintenance of the Water Supply and Sanitation Component is one (1) year.

- Open Competitive Bidding (OCB) will be conducted in accordance with ADB's Single-Stage: Two-Envelope bidding procedure and is open to all Bidders as described in the bidding document.
- Only experienced and eligible bidders with the following key qualifications should participate in this bidding:

Minimum average annual construction turnover of NRs. 669.00 million or equivalent calculated as total certified payments received for contracts in progress or completed within the last five (5) years.

- Participation in at least one contract that has been successfully or substantially completed within the last 7 (seven) years that is similar to the proposed works, where the value of the Bidder's participation exceeds NRs. 402.0 million or equivalent. The similarity of the Bidder's participation shall be based on the physical size, nature of works, complexity, methods, technology or other characteristics as described in Section 6, Employer's Requirements of the bidding

- 7. A pre-bid meeting shall be held at 13:00 Hrs. (NST) on 12 March 2021 at PMO Office at Panipokhari.
- Electronic bids must be submitted through PPMO's e-GP system www.bolpatra.gov.np/egp on or before 26 March 2021 12:00 Hrs. (NST). Bids received after this deadline will be rejected.
- Bids must be valid for a period of 120 days after bid opening and must be accompanied by a scanned copy of the bid security in pdf format in case of e-bid, amounting to NRs. 13.0 million, which shall be valid for 30 days beyond the validity period of the bid.
- 10. Technical bids will be opened in the presence of Bidders' representatives who choose to attend at 30 March 2021; 12:30 Hrs. (NST) at the Project Management Office, Urban Water Supply and Sanitation (Sector) Project, Panipokhari, Kathmandu. whereas the Financial Bids shall remain unopened. The Financial Bids of only Technically Responsive and Qualified Bidders shall be opened after Technical Bid Evaluation, whereas, the Financial Bids of those Bidders whose Technical Bids are not responsive and qualified shall be unopened.
